Proposed Management of Allergic Rhinitis on Medical Missions in Resource-Limited Settings

Case definition

Stated pregnancy or positive pregnancy test

Consider hospital referral for the following symptoms:

- 1. SBP >140 or DBP >90 (preeclampsia)
- 2. Proteinuria on urine dip
- 3. Vaginal bleeding

Clinical management

Fundal height and doptone if available

Pharmacologic management

Prenatal vitamin 1 tab po od Avoid smoking, caffeine, and alcohol *Adapted from:*
